


Directions to Tall Timbers Research Station



- From I-10 West, take exit 203, US 319 N. Stay in the rightmost lane and turn right at the light at the top of the hill (Capital Circle).
- Continue north through two lights and merge onto US 319.
- Proceed approximately 12.5 miles on US 319.
- Turn left onto SR 12 (also called Iamonia Cut-off). There is a sign marking the way to Tall Timbers. (If you reach Sunny Hill Rd or the Georgia state line, turn around!)
- Proceed west approximately 2.7 miles to Henry Beadel Drive on left. Beadel Drive is easy to miss.
 Watch carefully!
- Proceed south on Beadel Drive for about a mile, bear right at the Y, and park near the yellow barn.
