







Integrated Digitized Biocollections



NSF's Advancing Digitization of Biodiversity Collections (ADBC) Program is intended to put into digital format records of biodiversity specimens stored in all U.S. collections.

ADBC includes a nationally distributed network of TCNs, or Thematic Collections Networks, and other collaborating institutions and projects located across the U.S., and iDigBio (Integrated Digitized Biocollections), based at the University of Florida and Florida State University.





iDigBio is organizing the national digitization effort by working with TCNs and over 130 institutions by building teams and providing cyberinfrastructure to accomplish the goals of ADBC.
