Trilobite Facts

- Ceratarges existed from 402-388 million years ago during the Middle Devonian to Late Devonian periods.
- Trilobites are ancient arthropods. They are distant relatives of lobsters and spiders.
- With over 20,000 described species, trilobites are the most diverse class of extinct organisms.
- Trilobites ranged in size from 1 cm to over 70 cm.
