Improving Identifications

- ♦ 28% above the species level
- ♦ 65% below ‘expert’ confidence
- ♦ 56% have no notes
- ♦ Average note length: 179

- ◆ Better review process
- ◆ Document observations
- ◆ Computable descriptions
- ◆ Standardize ‘Provisional’ Names

What is an observation?


- ♦ Just the Facts

What is a species?

- ◆ Concept: “A group of organisms capable of interbreeding and producing fertile offspring”
- ◆ Definition: Type specimen, a name, and a circumscription that is **believed** to describe the species that specimen belongs to

- ◆ Changing Circumscriptions




