VertNet Vocabularies

Taxonomy Geography

Informed by:

- Multiple hand-selected authorities
- Millions of real occurrence records from published datasets

Geography

- · Don't miss this opportunity!
- 200,000 unique verified localities
- Authorities include GADM, Google Maps, Wikipedia, and more
- VertNet validates full geographies from continent to municipality

More than 100,000 genus terms validated

 VertNet taxonomic vocabularies are validated at the level of GENUS.

- 2 phases of validation
 - Automated
 - Manual

 Automated validation occurs during the use of the VertNet Migration Toolkit and multiple authorities.

Amphibians	AmphibiaWeb
Birds	Avibase
Fish	Catalog of Fishes
Mammals	Mammal Species of the World (3 rd)
Reptiles	Reptile Database
Paleobiology	Fossilworks

 Manual validation occurs when a genus cannot be validated unambiguously or cannot be identified by primary authorities.

- Authority priority:
 - Clade authority first, then,
 - Catalogue of Life / ITIS / Paleobiology Database
 - WoRMS / IRMNG / GBIF Taxonomic Backbone
 - » Published papers / other literature / Wikipedia

Taxonomy - Considerations

- VertNet keeps the verbatim source taxonomy
 - Resolves to dwc:HigherTaxonomy

 Vocabularies are not comprehensive, but are based on millions of real biodiversity records

Updates and additions are not scheduled

Look closely at the GBIF / Catalogue of Life collaboration

 iDigBio will likely to adopt the GBIF / CoL vocabularies when implemented.
