Summit

Why do we do the Summit? What is it for?

Day 0 - consists of TCN kickoff meetings, business meetings, and orientation

- We are trying to make the orientation better this year
- Topic ideas for this year's orientation:
 - Cover jargon and acronyms
 - Who is involved in national digitization effort
 - What is iDigBio? How do you get involved?
 - Preview of expectations - bimonthly reports, NSF reports (including integrated reports), data publishing to iDigBio, annual meeting
 - Project management
 - Mentoring and collaboration
- If people are new to ADBC or the Summit and PI's think the orientation would benefit them they are invited to attend day 0 but need to coordinate changes with Cathy.

Day 1 - consists of mostly presentations to provide introduction/updates about TCNs and ADBC.

- TCNs will get 5 minutes and 5 slides:
 - Progress in digitization efforts (this needs to be backed up by statistics/numbers; progress against what was planned)
 - Data management of & open access to data via iDigBio (data publication, How much of their data does iDigBio have to date?)
 - Research uses of data
 - Management & oversight of the network (What about network sustainability?)
 - What have you learned that can be shared with other TCNs? (This should address both issues around digitization and broader impact activities.)
- Q&A sessions after each block of talks
- Hour block at the end for other meetings, mentorship, etc.
- Evening reception and speaker at the Tennessee Aquarium

Day 2 consists of mostly breakouts and creating a common set of goals

- Start with some inspiration/collaboration talks
- Please self-select for the breakouts you'd like to be involved with
- Leads will be responsible for establishing the outline/expectations for their particular group
