Herbarium Digitization Workshop Monday Afternoon Schedule (September 17, 2012)

Immediately after lunch, at about 1:00 p.m., workshop participants will walk from the Rose Room to the herbarium in the Bailey Science Building (about 1 block), where at 1:15 p.m. Richard Carter will give a 30 minute presentation on Getting Started with Digitization.

- 3) Nikon camera and VSU workflow demonstration, herbarium, Gil Nelson
- 4) Specify data entry station, herbarium, Herrick Brown
