[Review of general SSH services]

iDigBio Phase 3 will establish a Symbiota Support Hub at ASU to provide support as needed to all Symbiota-based networks, including both retired and active TCNs as well as others and will include support for all versions of Symbiota. In addition, ASU will collaborate with CyVerse to provide hosting services for web accessible images used in portal displays.

The goals of the Symbiota Support Hub dovetail with those of various iDigBio domains:

- A. Provide daily Symbiota support to the hundreds of collections currently using the software (Domain 2).
- B. Coordinate and implement the novel Symbiota tools being developed by the TCNs across all networks (Domain 3).
- C. Promote better collaboration, communication, and training among managers of Symbiota networks across the country (Domain 2).
- D. Host and manage the networks and their associated images and integrate with iDigBio (Domain 3).
- E. Provide a low-barrier digitization software option to collections that have not yet become digitizing (Domains 1 & 2).
