You are strongly advised to take public transportation when visiting the UC Berkeley campus. It is a short walk to campus from the Downtown Berkeley BART station, and several AC Transit buses serve the campus. If you do choose to drive, allow yourself at least 20 minutes to park and walk to campus and be prepared to pay up to \$20/day. Carry coins and/or small bills if parking in campus lots. Be aware that **no free parking** exists at any time directly on the UC Berkeley campus (including Handicapped spots). Also remember that parking restrictions can vary due to special events, construction, et cetera.

### STREET PARKING

Residential permit parking zones in Berkeley do not apply on weekends and are designated on the map with speckling (see page two). One can park **for free** along the north and south sides of campus in residential areas on both Saturday and Sunday. However, read signs carefully because other parking restrictions do apply! Once parked, allow yourself 10-15 minutes to walk several blocks to the VLSB.

On Saturdays, street parking in the downtown business district is metered from 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM, but on Sundays metered parking is free all day for *most* of the streets shown on the map on page two. Again, read signs carefully!

### **#1** OXFORD GARAGE (2165 Kittredge St., west of Oxford Street)

Underground parking, located beneath the Oxford Plaza/David Brower Center complex. Pedestrian access from Allston Way, Oxford Street, and Kittredge Street. Open daily 8:00 a.m. to midnight, except major holidays. \$17/day (\$2/hour up to 6 hours)

# #2 Telegraph/Channing Garage (One-half block west of Telegraph Avenue, with entrances on both Durant Avenue and Channing Way)

Open 7 a.m. to 2 a.m. Fridays and Saturdays, and 8 a.m. to 10 p.m. on Sundays, except major holidays. \$16/day \$2/hour up to 6 hours)

#### **PARKING ON CAMPUS:**

Campus parking lots are available to the public on weekdays after 5 pm and on weekends, **if no campus events are occurring**. READ SIGNS CAREFULLY! Pay in advance at one of the yellow ticket machines in the lot: See machine for current rates (typically \$18/day).

You may be able to find parking at one of the following locations, all of which are close to VLSB: #3 RSF GARAGE (on Bancroft between Dana and Ellsworth), #4 DWINELLE LOT (at the end of Frank Schlessinger Way, south of VLSB), and #5 THE CRESCENT/WEST CIRCLE (west of VLSB, enter via Center St. or University Ave.).


